



Parent Involvement

A homeschool co-op consists of homeschooling families, dedicated tutors, passionate administrative team and a facility to partner with in ministry. Without one of these four key roles of the co-op we would not exist. It is intended not to replace education learned at home but supplement and enhance families' home education experience. The parent is the PRIMARY educator while enjoying the experience of having passionate tutors (not teachers) assist them in upper level courses and enrichment classes. We are providing the supplemental education by offering preschool programs, elementary enrichment classes and upper level core classes. Families can choose how many classes they wish to proceed with that best fits their needs.

The nature of a co-op is that parents are involved in every aspect of their students' schooling, and work together with other parents to educate their children collectively. Because we are NOT a school, but a parent cooperative for independent homeschoolers, all co-op families have active roles in many areas of CHEAR.

There are a multitude of parent roles that require investment and time, but are invaluable for the success of our program. In the 2024-25 School Year, every family will be required to commit to 16 hours of Service Hours.
